INTRODUCTION

Everyone has different goals and expectations for what they want to achieve from the show. You might have varying levels of sales success, but the key lies in how you present yourself to the public. Be open and inviting, answer any questions they may have, and remain courteous. Remember, "You never get a second chance to make a good first impression."

Make as many contacts and connections as possible, as networking is essential for growing your business. This is the primary purpose of our show: to promote your business and establish relationships that can help you sell more beyond the event.

Setup, Check In, Unloading & Packing Up Info

Setup for vendors and food trucks will take place on Saturday morning, July 26th, starting at 10:00 AM. This will be done on a first-come, first-served basis.

To facilitate an easy setup, we will do our best to position everyone near their designated booths. As the event approaches, we will send out more detailed information via email regarding check-in procedures, vendor parking, booth assignments, and other relevant details.

Booth Area & Presentation

Each participant will have either a 10x10 or 10x20 space. Setups will be located on the street or sidewalk, and a canopy-type tent is allowed. While a canopy is not mandatory, it is recommended for better visual presentation. Please ensure that all tents are weighed down with a minimum of 50 lbs per leg, as per Fire Marshal recommendation

No tables or chairs will be provided, so please bring your own setup. All displays, racks, merchandise, etc., must remain within your designated booth area. Additionally, you are responsible for removing all garbage and items at the end of the event; please do not leave anything behind.

Overnight Information

Since this show is only one day, we do not provide overnight setup.

Takedown At The End Of The Show

Please remember the following important information regarding the event: Early takedowns are strictly prohibited. Your portion of the event concludes at 6:00 PM. If you start taking down your booth before this time, you will be disqualified from participating in any future events. We understand that each event can be a long day, but it is vital to ensure that customers who arrive later receive the same experience as those

who attended from the start. You are only permitted to pack up after the show officially ends at 6:00 PM. Please be prepared to transport your items several hundred feet back to your vehicle, depending on your booth's location. We will provide additional updates as the event approaches if we can implement a safer loading procedure for everyone. More details will be emailed to you closer to the event date. Thank you for your understanding.

Insurance

We are not responsible for any of your items due to weather, lost, stolen or damage. We are also not responsible for any injury or bodily harm. You are responsible to carry your own insurance.

Severe Weather

This is a rain or shine event. In the event of severe weather, we will communicate with everyone via our Facebook page about what actions the event will be taking. If the entire show is canceled due to severe weather, you will receive a credit towards next year's show. No refunds will be given.

Cancellations

We do not provide refunds if you are unable to attend or you cancel an event.

- If you cancel and the event is more than 60 days away, we will then roll any money paid to the following year's event.
- If you cancel within 60 days of the event, unfortunately will not receive any credit to a future event.
- If you do not make it to the show without contacting us, you will be removed from any future shows without a refund. You also will not be able to participate in any future events.

Food Vendors

Food may only be sold by pre-approved vendors. All food vendors must follow the Michigan Cottage Food Laws (MDARD - Michigan Cottage Foods Information) or be licensed. You must register with the St. Clair County Health Department if you have not already done so. We do provide the St. Clair County Health Department and the Port Huron Fire Marshall a list of all Food Vendors.
